Berry Show LIVESTOCK

At the heart of the Berry Show lies the traditional world of livestock. Horses, cattle, goats and poultry all take centre stage. Showcasing an impressive variety of exhibits over two-days, the 2025 Berry Show promises a remarkable celebration of excellence in livestock!

Showjumping and Horse Classes

The Showjumping program runs daily from 7.30am on Friday, where accomplished riders can earn points for the South Coast and Tablelands Showjumping Pointscore. Showjumping continues on Saturday.

The other horse programs featuring both led and ridden classes, commence at 9am on Friday and 8.30am on Saturday. Judging will take place in four rings within the McGoldrick Main Arena.

You'll also find heavy horses and other horse events taking place over the weekend.

Dairy Cattle

Judging begins at 9am on Friday, showcasing a top-notch exhibition of the major dairy breeds. The judging will take place on the Cattle Lawn next to the Poultry Pavilion.

Beef Cattle

Saturday sees the spotlight shift to beef cattle judging, which kicks-off at 8.30am with the European breeds. The British Breeds competition follows.

The Paraders and the Junior Steer Pointscore Competitions enable younger participants to get involved with classes for participants of all ages.

The beef cattle section draws to a close with the Trade Hoof Competition that is open to steers & heifers, which will later be sold at auction.

Just like the dairy cattle, the beef cattle judging takes place on the Cattle Lawn next to the Poultry Pavilion.

Berry Show encourages the move towards a disease-free status for all exhibits.

The Stewards will ensure:

- · Tested negative animals will be housed separately from other animals.
- · Every effort will be made to immediately remove faecal material to an isolated area.
- · Separate fresh water facilities will be made available.

JOHNE'S DISEASE:

The society will permit both tested and untested animals. The current status of exhibitors' herds must be notified upon entry or prior to judging day.

 Declarations for all Johne's Disease tested cattle must be produced to the Chief Steward before unloading cattle on Show day.

BIOSECURITY

As from August 2019 the Biosecurity Act has been amended. Livestock farmers need to demonstrate they observe Animal Welfare Standards & Guidelines - details at mla.com.au/ biosecurity (tools & resources). Cattle will not be able to access communal water troughs.

Due to Biosecurity, competitors must supply, use and remove their own cattle's bedding. Waste disposal bin on site.

General Conditions for Beef Cattle Section

- Cattle Pavilion is not available until after 3.30pm on Friday unless prior arrangements are made with the Chief Stewards.
- All cattle must be unloaded and loaded at the four ramps in Albany Street.
- Age of cattle to be taken as at 1st February 2024 inclusive.
- All cattle must be registered with their particular Breed Society.
- All bulls under 12 months and ALL females must be kept under control and led with a nose grip on at all times.
- All bulls 12 months and over must be kept under control and led with a ring. The handlers must be over twelve years of age
- Paraders are requested to wear breed dust coats or breed uniforms i.e., vest, tie, etc.
- Two rings will be in operation.
- All animals in each class are to enter the ring in age order with the youngest first and oldest last.
- Should any Bos indicus (e.g., Brahman, Santa Gertrudis, etc.) cattle be entered in the Show, these will compete in the British Breeds classes.

All electrical leads and appliances are to be tagged and kept off the ground.

Cattle must be loaded by 3pm and shed left clean. Cattle must use their own water containers.
